LWVVC Mission Statement

The League of Women Voters of Volusia County (LWVVC) is a nonpartisan political organization that works to:

- Encourage the informed and active participation of citizens in government
- Influence public policy through citizen education and advocacy

The League does not support or endorse any political party or candidate.

The League does take positions on selected issues that we study and discuss. When we have reached agreement on an issue, we take action to effect change.

Our goal is to empower citizens to shape better communities.

It takes an active and involved citizenry to make democracy work.

What Kinds of Issues Does the LWVVC Study?

In recent years, LWVVC members have delved into issues such as these:

Health Care:

Which policies best promote broad access to quality care while controlling costs? What are the implications of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act? Are there adequate mental and dental services for local residents?

Water:

What is the quality of Volusia County's water? How will we balance demand for water with protection of our aquifers and rivers?

Redistricting:

What reforms are necessary to ensure Florida's redistricting processes are fair and non-partisan?

Transportation:

What investment and infrastructure are needed to promote efficient and cost-effective connections within our county and central Florida?

How Do We Serve Volusia County?

Voter Service:

We moderate candidate forums, register voters, and provide speakers to explain proposed amendments and issues on the ballot. We send questionnaires to local candidates, with questions specific to their races, and post their responses on our website.

Speakers Bureau:

LWVVC provides to other organizations and groups LWVVC speakers who are well-versed in issues we are currently studying.

Citizen Information:

We share information about local elections and local elected officials and issues important to our residents and visitors via our newsletter, our website, our Facebook page, and monthly general meetings. People contact us via e-mail and our League phone.

Service on Advisory Boards:

League members are often appointed to local and state committees and commissions.
